Dear parents and carers,

I want to sincerely thank you all for the tremendous work over the last couple of weeks in supporting us as we navigated a very uncertain time together. We look forward to welcoming all students back to the College next week and in preparation for next week, please see the information below for your information and consideration:

- All students are welcome back to the College from Monday the 25th of May. The first week back will focus on settling students into routine again and assessing where students are up to with their learning. All classes, school rules, policies and procedures that were in place before the lockdown now come back into place.
- Learning at home support from your child's teacher will cease from 2:35pm on Friday the 22nd of May as teachers prepare for the return of students to the classroom.
- If you choose to keep your child or children at home please inform the College on Monday the 25th of May. You will need to access the learning@home website (qld.gov.au/learningathome) to continue your child's education.
- The current government directive is that parents and carers should drop their children off at the school gates and not enter the school grounds. I kindly request that all parents and carers continue to follow this directive. If you need to meet with a staff member in person please make an appointment with the staff member prior to attending either campus.
